The transportation committee meeting was called to order at 7:21AM on Saturday, Sept. 18 in the superintendent's office by Chairperson Paul Baer. (The meeting was moved from Subway at 7:17 AM because they weren't open.) The purpose of the meeting was to discuss bus maintenance and develop a recommendation for approval by the Board of Education at the October regular meeting.

The pros and cons of various options were discussed.

There was a concern about account balances being due 30 days from service completion with Buhl's Auto Repair and Auto Body if Board of Education meetings fall more than 30 days apart. We called Tony Buhl and he said that could be changed to 45 days without a penalty.

The transportation committee recommends to the Board of Education that work covered under the warranty on current buses will still be done at Midwest Transit where the buses were purchased and warranty work will be performed there. The remainder of our routine bus maintenance, inspections and repair work will be done with Buhl Auto Repair & Auto Body, pending reference checks, for one year.

The meeting adjourned at 8:19 AM.
