

Public Act 96-0434

On August 13, 2009 Governor Quinn signed into law P.a. 96-0434, which creates two new *School Code* provisions that require school district to annually prepare an itemized salary compensation report for every employee holding an administrative certificate and working in that capacity.

The report must be:

- 1) Presented as an information item at a regularly scheduled school board meeting.
- 2) Sent to the Regional Office of Education; and
- 3) Be posted on the school district website by October 1.
