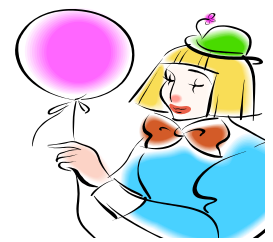

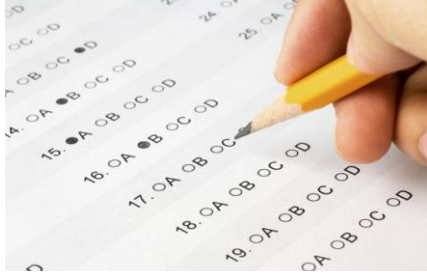
Let's Get Ready for Kindergarten!

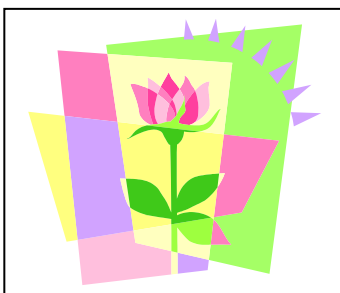
